**Grade Five Social Studies Teachers Needed for Grant Research and Pilot**

The Salem Maritime Historic Site is seeking two or three grade five teachers (social studies focus) to pilot a program for fifth grade classes on board the Friendship, the 18th century replica sailing vessel and to connect the maritime history with ocean stewardship. The Salem Maritime Historic Site would like to create interdisciplinary and active components that help meet the fifth grade social studies and science/technology frameworks.

The Salem Maritime Historic Site is applying for a National Park Foundation grant called America's Best Idea based on Ken Burns' new PBS series on the National Parks. This grant will provide funding to offer two to three fifth grade teachers stipends to help us develop this new program and to cover bus transportation for their classes to pilot the program in spring 2010.

Time Commitment: 20 to 30 hours in total: 10-15 hours of meeting times after school including one Saturday workshop (4 to 5 hours), an additional 10 to 15 hours to develop lesson plans/activities for the pilot program, and 1 to 2 hours to evaluate the program following execution will be required.

*The planning meetings would be between late January and early February through end of March. Hopefully, pilot the program in April/May with their class.*

*One planning day needs to be a Saturday probably 10 to 2 or 2:30 with lunch provided so participants can tour the ship during daylight hours in winter months as planning must begin in January/February.*

Payment: \$35 per hour/ grant funded
